II Reading with Comprehension

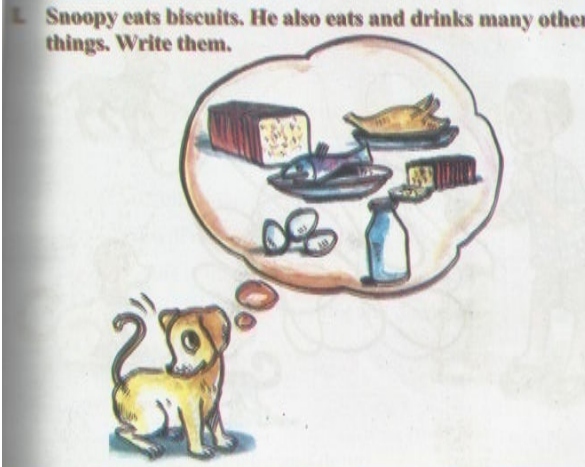

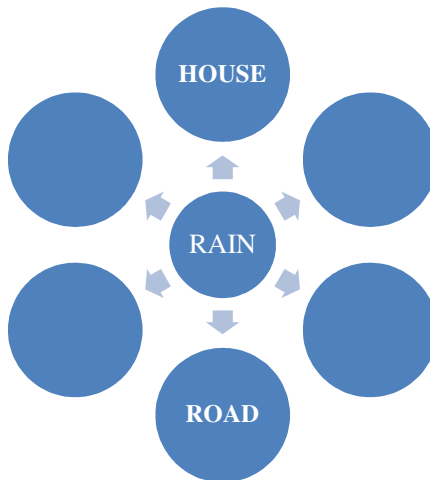
